Location of first-aid equipment:	In middle door of Pavilion facing field (café area)		
Location of Defibrillator:	Next to main door of Memorial Hall, in a locked cabinet.

How to contact Emergency Services:	Mobile phones		
How will Emergency Services be directed to the scene of an incident:	Home team coaches		
Who else is available to help in case of issues:	Coaches, parents, adult club members.		
Managed Venue:			
Evacuation:	<p>If anyone suspects fire/gas leak/structural failure or other reason to evacuate alert all players and coaches with a sharp long whistle.</p> <p>Ensure that no-one returns to the changing rooms to collect their belongings.</p> <p>Coaches to ensure all own players evacuate and congregate in the car park on the Primary School playground.</p> <p>Coaches should check all their players are accounted for.</p> <p>If anyone missing, notify any emergency services present.</p> <p>Do not re-enter the playing field or Pavilion until instructed to do so by coach or Emergency Services.</p>		

Missing Person:	<p>For Junior members</p> <p>Alert coaches and adult MCFC members.</p> <p>Search of premises with above members.</p> <p>Contact parents – call Police.</p>
Minor Injury:	<p>First aid should only be given by a qualified First Aider.</p> <p>The first aider will normally be the team coach.</p> <p>Coaches should remember to consider the safety of other participants and stop / suspend the session if they are distracted by dealing with the casualty</p> <p>The First Aider should treat the casualty in line with the guidance of their qualification.</p> <p>When treating a casualty don't leave yourself in a compromising position. e.g. male first aider alone with a female casualty or adult alone with a child.</p> <p>Coaches should follow the CLUB accident reporting online procedure including noting the incident on the session plan (if applicable) and completing an incident/accident report form.</p>
Major Injury:	<p>(All cases of head injury should be treated as serious.)</p> <p>Ensure emergency services are notified giving address at top of form.</p> <p>Coaches should go and get First Aid kit and Defibrillator immediately from middle door inside the Memorial Hall and bring back to casualty. Defibrillator is on the wall on the right inside the middle doors of the Pavilion, see diagram below.</p> <p>Coaches should only attend to the casualty in line with their first aid qualification, take control of all other players at the field and move them away from the player.</p> <p>Await arrival of emergency services, continuing to treat casualty, assist them and hand over when they have taken responsibility.</p> <p>Provide Emergency services with details of any medication, known medical history and emergency contact details; these are available from applicable coach, and/or access to membership database.</p>
Nearest Hospital	<p>Horton General Hospital, Banbury, OX16 9AL.</p> <p>The hospital is on the A4260 Oxford Road at its junction with Hightown Road, about two thirds of a mile south of Banbury town centre and about 100 metres north of Sainsbury's store.
